This four-hour hands-on workshop is designed for educators and will help them to better manage chemical and other hazards to reduce risk in a teaching environment. The goal of this workshop is to provide classroom teachers, school administrators, chemical hygiene officers, and science museum professionals with a toolbox for the safe management and use of the chemicals in all educational settings (middle and high school classrooms, science museums, and any other educational environment).

Workshop topics will include the most recent information on the GHS system of labeling chemicals, chemical inventory and storage, risk assessment, the basics of hazardous waste management, how to evaluate the safety quality of a YouTube clip, and how to evaluate the quality of a safety data sheet. Many new resources developed by the American Chemical Society will be discussed. The workshop leader is Ms. Samuella Sigmann, CCHO, of Appalachian State University.
